

Welcome to the RunsWktsOvers channel where tonight we will be demonstrating how to use the DL Calculator within the Play Cricket Scorer app.

DL stands for Duckworth Lewis which is a method of calculating a new target score for a team batting second in a limited overs cricket match that has been shortened mainly due to weather but could be for any other reason.

The DL method is available in two formats, DL Standard and DLS Professional. When using the Professional method, an 'S' appears in the method name to represent Professor Stern who is responsible for the software used to perform DLS Professional Calculations. The two methods are not interchangeable, as they produce different target scores in the same scenarios. The Play Cricket Scorer app has a DL Standard Calculator embedded in it, which is the version we are looking at tonight on RunsWktsOvers.

The DL Calculator is available as a standalone function and as an accessible feature while scoring. The Play Cricket Scorer app is available to download free of charge on both iOS and Android devices (tablets and smartphones).
