

Getting Started with Play Cricket Scorer (PCS), the scoring app available to download free of charge on smartphones and tablets.

The session will cover: -

- Downloading a match from Play-Cricket.
- Setting up a match from scratch.
- Scoring preferences.
- Match setup
- Scoring basics

The PCS app has an inbuilt match type for scoring pairs cricket, a demo match to help you practice without doing any match setup, as well as the capability to 'Live Score' a fixture from the Play Cricket database.

When a return to recreational cricket is permitted, scorers may not want to handle a communal scorebook and scoring with the PCS app may be a useful alternative. Live Scores could be posted on your Play-Cricket website, reducing the number of requests for individual batting/bowling figures and therefore interaction with players and spectators.

This session follows on from last week's Pairs Cricket Scoring session, as the PCS app has the capability of scoring Pairs Cricket and could prove useful to anyone wanting to score this type of cricket in the future.
