There will be an explanation of the umpire's signals involved and a demonstration of how to record penalty runs on a Box style (traditional) scoresheet, to aid understanding of which parts of the scoresheet are affected by penalty runs.

They will also look at how penalty runs are recorded in Play Cricket Scorer Professional (PCS Pro) and the Play-Cricket Scorer (PCS) app.

For the PCS Pro illustration, a local match will be created at the time. To follow along, please create your own local match using any teams/players in advance or simultaneously with the presenter.

For the PCS app display, the presenter will use the demo PCS demo match. To follow along, please download the PCS app to your tablet or smart phone beforehand.

To round off the session, they will look at the scoresheet entries required if a player is suspended due to a level 3 or 4 offence under Law 42.

PCS Pro is available to download free-of-charge from the Play Cricket website <http://play-cricket.com/features-playcricketscorerpro> but note PCS Pro is not being taught from scratch in this session.
